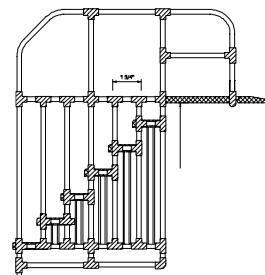

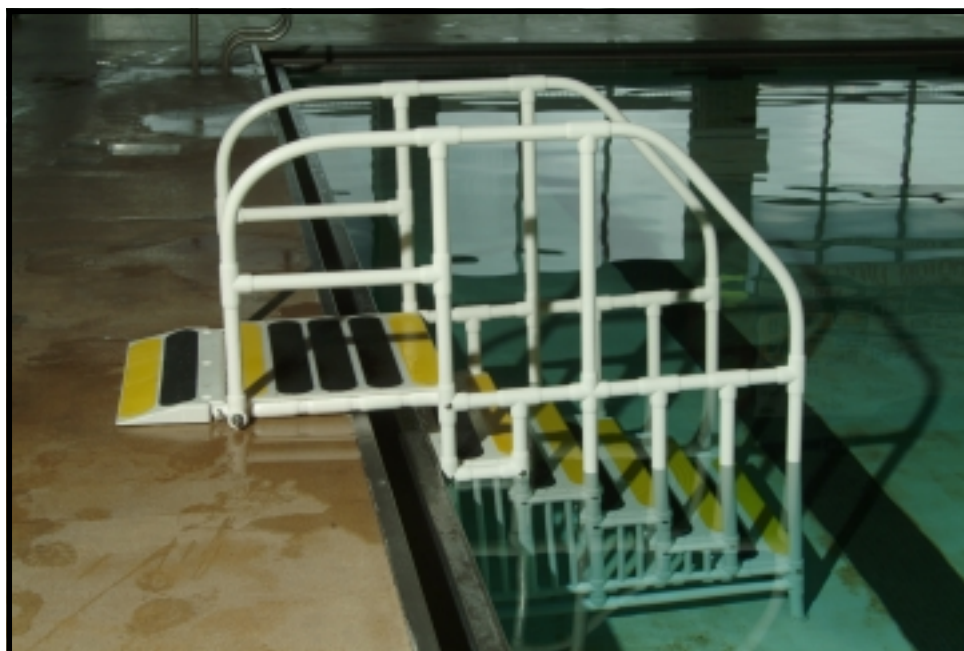
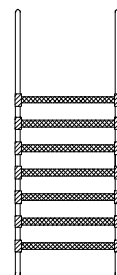

**Q. How do you know which model of Ladder to choose?**

**A.** Choose your AquaTrek Ladder based on it's riser height, or distance between steps. The riser height is determined by the depth of your pool from pool floor to the deck surface. A really deep pool will need a ladder with more steps than a shallow pool. An example would be an AQ-5000 AquaTrek 5-Treaded Ladder going into a pool 44-inches deep will have a smaller riser height than an AQ-5000 going into a pool 50-inches deep. The 44-inch deep pool unit would have approximately 7-1/2 inches as it's riser height, whereas the 50-inch deep pool would have an AQ-5000 with an approximate riser height of 8-1/2 inches.

**Q. What is considered a therapeutic riser height?**

**A.** Anywhere from 5-1/2 to 7 inches is what would be considered the best, most comfortable steps for someone who has a disability. Just as a visual reference, 5-1/2 inches is about the height of a soda pop can.
